

# Arrival Information for Pre-Orientation



## Getting to Campus

### **If you are flying to St. Louis:**

A free shuttle will be available every 30 minutes from 9:00am – 4:00pm from both terminals at the Lambert Airport.

**Terminal 1:** First Year Center Staff, who will be wearing **WHITE** shirts with Washington University Student Associate on the back, will be located on the lower level, near the baggage claims. They will assist you in boarding the free shuttle to Washington University.

**Terminal 2:** Check in with the WU Welcome Table located on the lower level between the down escalator and the baggage claim area. Look for First Year Center Staff, who will be wearing **WHITE** shirts with Washington University Student Associate on the back. They will direct you to the welcome table and assist you in boarding the free shuttle to Washington University.

If you are arriving later than 4:00pm, or your plane is delayed, you can either take a taxi, airport shuttle, or the Metrolink to campus. ### **If you are driving to campus:**

For your destination, use the address:

1 Shepley Drive, Clayton, MO 63105

Some navigation systems may also recognize St. Louis as the city, but this is the official name of the city that Wash U sits in. **Be sure that you are navigating to Shepley Drive from Big Bend Boulevard;** there is no entrance at Wydown Blvd. or Wallace Drive even though your GPS may direct you to those streets.

If you are living on the South 40, turn onto Shepley Drive from Big Bend Blvd. First Year Center staff will greet you and give you directions to pick up your key at Residential Life as well as give you information about unloading and parking.

## Check-in on the South 40

### **When you arrive on campus, you will need to check-in at two locations:**

1. **Get your key at Residential Life**, located in the South 40 House, across the street from the Clocktower. You will receive your keys and a First Year Center packet that includes your Bear Beginnings schedule, student ID, and your U-Pass for the Metrobus and Metrolink. Please be sure to bring a picture ID to pick up your packet.

2. **Check-In with your Pre-Orientation Program**, located in Ursa's Fireside or Stageside, next to the Clocktower on the South 40. Your counselors will give you information specific to your program.

**IMPORTANT!!!** Although you will check in at Residential Life on Sunday, August 16, you must ALSO check in at your residence hall on Thursday, August 20. You will receive important information from your specific residence hall at that time.
